



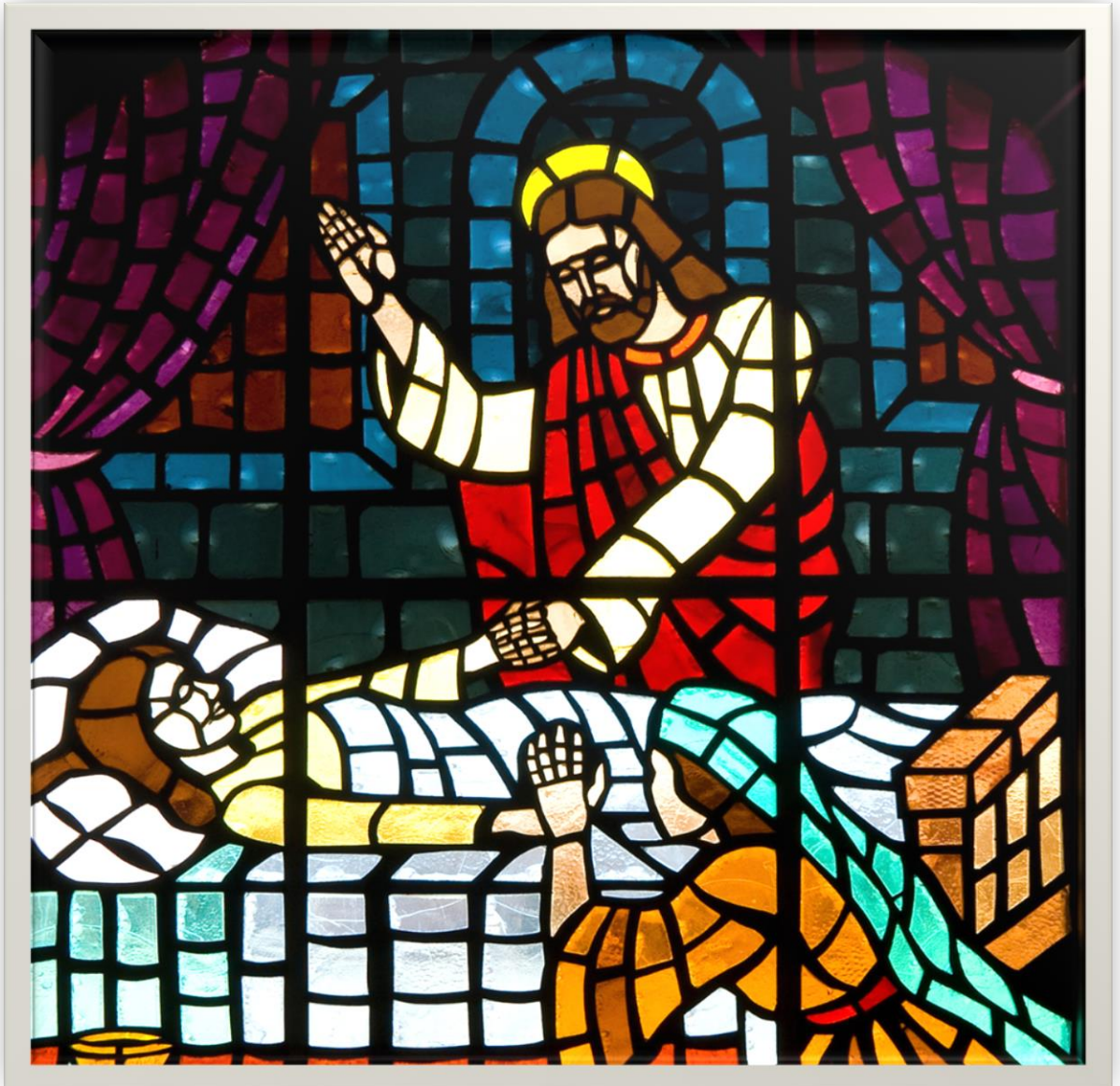

### A READING FROM THE WISDOM OF SOLOMON
